



SCHOOL DRESS CODE

► Elementary School:

Students must wear solid black or navy blue shorts, slacks, “skorts”, or skirts that are neat in appearance. “Skinny jeans”, sweats, “form-fitting pants, or leggings (hip huggers) are not permitted. Acceptable fabrics are cotton and poly-cotton blends. Denim is not permitted. White school polo shirts displaying the logo must be worn. If the student wears an undershirt, that shirt should be white too. School shirts and acceptable pants/shorts are available through local vendors. Blue or black “sweaters” are allowed.

PE Uniform: All students will wear black sport shorts.

Option 1: The school cotton grey shirt

Option 2: A grey “dry-fit” shirt with the school logo printed on the left side of the chest

Athletic-type shoes or flats are suitable to wear to school. Please note that no flip-flop sandals or other slide-in shoes are permitted as student footwear. Hats and sunglasses are not to be worn during class. The school expects the use of hats whenever students are outdoors for recess. Our expectation is a “no hat – no play” philosophy.

► Secondary School:

1. Female Students: All students must wear the white polo with the school logo on the left side of the chest.

Option 1: Black Knee-length skirts

Option 2: Black Pants (regular or loose fit, not skinny-fit)

o Sits just below waist

o Straight through hip and thigh

o Straight leg

Option 3: Black Bermudas (cargo style)

2. Male Students: All students must wear the white polo with the school logo on the left side of the chest.

Option 1: Black Pants (regular or loose fit, not skinny-fit)

o Sits just below waist.

o Easy through thigh.

o Straight leg.

Option 2: Black Bermudas (cargo style)

3. PE Uniform: All students will wear black sport shorts.

Option 1: The school cotton grey shirt

Option 2: A grey “dry-fit” shirt with the school logo printed on the left side of the chest

Option 3: The AASSA shirt for use of “inside school” PE activities.

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4. School Sweater: Will be offered by a local vendor and will be mandatory for all students. Look at attached pictures.

NO DENIM will be accepted in any of the uniform options.

Non-uniform Days

When students are granted “non-uniform” days, they are expected to dress appropriately for a school setting. Muscle shirts, “crop” (cut off) tops, spaghetti straps or “hip-hugger” type pants are not permitted. Clothing containing inappropriate language or references to alcohol, tobacco, or other types of drugs is not permitted.

The administration reserves the right to send home any student whose clothing does not meet expectations.

When student does not comply with appropriate uniform:

- 1/2x- warnings are given. Out of uniform slip gets accumulated via Registrar's Office. Call to parents regarding need for uniform compliance.
- 3/4x- detentions. 30 minute/60 minute detention within the same week (if possible). Call to parents regarding need for uniform compliance
- 5x- in-school suspension within the same day. To be recorded as excused absence from class. Schedule meeting with parents regarding compliance.
- 6+ -student must be sent home for the day. Student must be given failing grade for unexcused absence.



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
